## PROJECT NARRATIVE

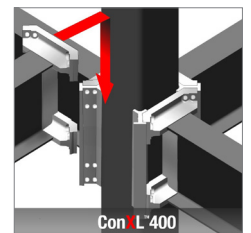
This three-story, 89,964 ft<sup>2</sup> facility is a new model facility that incorporates both medical and dental care in one building. It is the first of its kind for a Kaiser Permanente facility in the Northwest US, replacing an existing building that has served Kaiser members for over 40 years. It is also targeted to be a LEED Gold status building.

## CONX SOLUTIONS

ConX was the ideal solution for the redevelopment of this medical office building. The adjacent existing medical office building remained open during construction, and will be demolished upon completion of the new facility. ConX provided both a clean and efficient site laydown, and a swift erection process - benefitting the overall project schedule.
