## PROJECT NARRATIVE

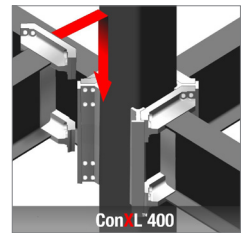
Kaiser Permanente is expanding the existing medical office building facility in San Marcos, California, adding an additional 71,794 ft<sup>2</sup> 3-story facility directly adjacent to the current building. The building has a contemporary design with curtain wall and glass exterior, and a significant exposed steel awning.

## CONX SOLUTIONS

The structure including trellis were erected in just 12 days, with the remaining decking, misc. metals and concrete fill completed over the next 13 days.
